Herbal remedies, supplements, vitamins, medicines you buy yourself from a pharmacy or supermarket, or rongoā therapies can interact with warfarin. Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking them.



Tell all healthcare providers that you are taking warfarin (eg, your doctor, dentist or pharmacist). You may need to stop warfarin before an operation, dental care and some tests.



If you have missed a dose, take the missed dose if you remember on the same day. If it's the next day, skip the missed dose and carry on as usual. Do not take two doses on the same day. Record the missed dose in your diary and tell your doctor on your next visit.
